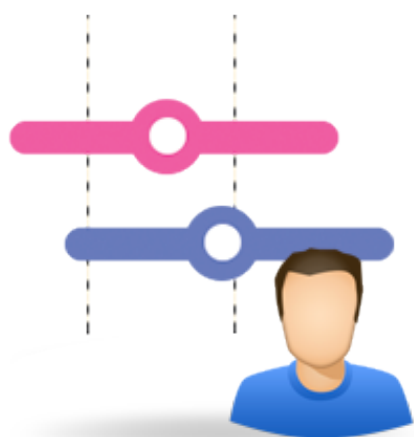

French publisher Heredis, a leading figure in the world of genealogy and a pioneer with its cooperative model, announces the launch of its brand new version: Heredis 2026. With this ambitious update, the company aims to advance the exploration of family history by combining family history with global and local historical events.

### TIMELINES



At some point, every genealogist dreams of being able to present their work. With Heredis 2026, amateur and expert genealogists alike can now visualize their data in the form of personal and family timelines, highlighting data that they may not have seen before. These chronological representations shed light on the life trajectories of ancestors, allowing users to understand family ties and historical contexts at a glance and present their genealogy in a fun way. Combined with tools such as Smart Search, genealogists can highlight specific persons in their family tree by isolating ancestors who shared the same profession, for example. These representations can be exported in PNG format for use in blogs, presentations, or family albums.

Beyond their visual appeal, timelines can also be valuable tools for genealogists. They make it easier to interpret certain gray areas. Unclear or incomplete periods become immediately identifiable, saving considerable time in further research. Heredis 2026 transforms every “gap” into an opportunity for discovery. “*In genealogical research, we focus primarily on the individual stories of each person or their family,*” explains H  l  ne from Heredis, a certified genealogist and training manager at Heredis. “*It can be*

*very useful to take into account the local or global context to explain or find certain links. That's what our new version allows you to do,*” explains H  l  ne.

### HISTORICAL FACTS INDEX

The Index of historical facts, allows you to place each ancestor in their historical context. Better still, users can add their own facts based on places of origin and share these references with other enthusiasts. This new feature enhances the collaborative aspect of the software.

## SETS OF PARENTS

With Heredis 2026, every genealogist can now add more diverse parental links. The "Parents" tab allows you to enter and differentiate between biological parents (displayed by default when opening a file converted to version 2026), adoptive parents, blended families, and other educational or emotional relationships such as step-parents, foster parents, etc. These distinctions appear in the books, records, and trees generated by the software, as well as in searches and mergers.



## MULTIPLE SURNAMES

The processing of multiple surnames (father/mother) has been refined to better reflect cultural practices without complicating databases, while remaining compliant with law. For example, a child bearing the surname of both their father and mother, "John/Martinez," will be correctly linked to their origins without creating an additional compound surname in the genealogist's database. Only the surnames "John" and 'Martinez' will be counted, for a clearer database. The entry is simply made with a "/".

## SPANISH AND ASSOCIATIVE NETWORK

Other notable new features: Heredis now speaks Spanish, opening it up to new users. At the same time, an integrated directory makes it easier to connect with local genealogy societies, promoting local exchanges (from Online Archives).

## IMPROVEMENTS

Heredis 2026 is the result of extensive collaboration between our users in the field and our development team behind the scenes to improve the software.

**A more user-friendly interface:** the option palettes on the genealogy wheels have been completely redesigned with improved contrast and clear visual cues.

The list of events includes a **column to display their flags**.

In the Families from my Village book, genealogists can now **remove contemporaries** if they wish to distribute it to a wider audience.

Users can **edit the titles of wheels and timelines** and export them in PNG format to publish their work on a blog, for example.

From the Persons Panel, Media Panel, Isolated Branches, and Media Index, genealogists can now **filter using multiple flags to refine their selection**.

This version includes numerous **bug fixes** reported by users to improve the software's performance and reliability.
